

AGA Audio Conference Series

Just envision a 100-minute radio talk show that provides two continuing professional education (CPE) hours to the listeners. Further, since the last 20 minutes of the program is devoted to call-in questions, the audio conference provides interaction between the listeners and speakers.

The speakers are subject matter experts and will provide PowerPoint presentations or other handouts for the site coordinators to download and copy, as well as project to a screen, so participants can follow along during the telecast.

These telecasts are generally produced in conjunction with the National Association of State Auditors, Comptrollers and Treasurers (NASACT) and the Association of Local Government Auditors (ALGA). NASACT plans to do four additional audio conferences during the same period. Thus, you can earn as many as 16 CPE hours from these training experiences.
