### “ASSESSING RISK IN PERFORMING AUDITS” by DAVID R. HANCOX, CGFM, CIA

Mr. Hancox is a Director in the Division of State Government Accountability in the NYS Comptroller’s Office. He is currently leading an effort to measure the performance of state agencies’ financial management practices to guide future audit efforts and to increase the effectiveness of agency operations.

He is co-author of two books: *Government Performance Audit in Action* (The 3<sup>rd</sup> Edition was published in January 2008) and *State and Local Government, Program Control and Audit: Handbook for Managers and Auditors*. He is on the faculty of Siena College and the Government Audit Training Institute - Graduate School, USDA.

He is an international speaker and in frequent demand in the government audit and financial management community on audit and management-related topics. He is past regional vice president of the Association of Government Accountants and a past president of the New York Capital Chapter of that organization.
